Gaelic Glen Hunter/Jumper Show Rules and Regulations

- 1. <u>Helmets</u>: Anyone mounted on a horse on the competition grounds, must wear approved helmets, with safety harness correctly fastened, at all times.
- 2. <u>OE Membership</u>: Riders and owners must provide proof of 2025 Ontario Equestrian (OE) membership on entry form.
- 3. <u>Vaccinations</u>: Upload your current year vax record with your entry. Vaccinations must have been completed within 6 months but more than one week before the show. A current Coggins must be available upon request.
- 4. <u>Abuse</u> Abuse of the horse is strictly forbidden. Excessive use of the whip a horse should never be hit more than three times for any one incident.
- 5. NSF cheques will be assessed a \$50 surcharge. Cancelled entries and any refunds will be assessed a \$30 plus administration fee. No shows \$50 plus admin. *If you withdraw your horse from competition once the show has commenced there will be no refund of entry fees.*
- 6. <u>Entries:</u> Post entries add \$30, no exceptions. All entries received by the secretary following the closing date will be deemed a post entry. If you substitute one horse for another there will be no additional cost.
- 7. <u>All competition numbers</u> must be worn and be visible at all times during the competition.
- 8. **<u>Rider Falls</u>**: Remounting in the ring not allowed.

9. Scratch: after closing date but more than 48 hrs. before show start: Admin fee (\$65 + hst) will be charged.

10. There are no refunds for scratches less than 48 hrs before show start. May substitute another horse/rider.

N.B. This show has Paramedic Services on the grounds throughout the day. In the event medical help is required, contact the nearest radio equipped show staff person.

Classes Available

HACK DIVISION –This division shall consist of Road, Show and Pleasure Hack. Open to all horses and ponies. Additional requirement for the Road Hack class will be the demonstration of a strong trot. Additional requirements for the Show Hack class will be collected and extended gaits. Both Road and Show hack classes may be required to Hand Gallop (never more than 8 horses at one time). Pleasure hack will never be required to Hand Gallop. Martingales, breastplates, boots of any kind and/or bandages are not permitted. Drop and flash nose bands are prohibited. Brow bands shall be leather of any description but not solid white, colored or sequined. In the event of a tie for Champion or Reserve Champion, horses shall be shown in hand and judged on conformation.

GREEN HUNTER $-18^{\circ}/2^{\circ}0/2^{\circ}3$ Open to horses in their first or second year of showing.

OPEN HUNTER 2'/2'3/2'6 – Open to all.

JR/AM Medal (2'0, 2'3 or 2'6): Open to all Junior or Amateur riders. There will be one round over fences. All riders, or a minimum of 4 riders who complete the Jumping phase, shall be called back to perform on the flat. Additional testing may be required at the judge's discretion. Jumping 60% Flat: 40% of the score.

HUNTER CLASSIC (2'3, 2'6 or 2'9) Open to all. Two Rounds. Top 8 from the first round will return for the second round.

BEGINNER: Open to riders under 18, in their first year of showing (except in-stable shows). Simple course of 6–8 poles. No cantering permitted. Riders may be led or have someone walking beside them.

X-RAILS: Competitors may trot or canter any part of the course. Trotting is not penalized. May enter into the Short Stirrup/Long Stirrup division.

SHOWMANSHIP IN HAND: Exhibitors are judged on exhibiting the animal to its best advantage, with additional scoring for the grooming and presentation of both horse and handler. They will be asked to walk and jog.

IN-HAND HUNTER/JUMPER SUITABILITY: Open to all horses and ponies. Judged on the ability of the horse/pony to excel in hunter/jumper or dressage disciplines. To be judged in hand- 50% on movement and 50% on confirmation and type.

SHORT STIRRUP/LONG STIRRUP: Fences not to exceed 18"

Fences will not exceed 18 inches and the course will be comprised of a maximum of eight fences. Course to consist of verticals only, no oxers. Short stirrup/Long stirrup riders may not enter any other classes except for Hack Division and the X-Rails division. Open to both horses and ponies, but lines (distances) will not be adjusted.

JR/AM EQUITATION: 2'0: No Oxers. Classes are judged as Equitation. May cross-enter into Open Hunter or Jr/Am Medal.

THE "NAVARRO" ADULT WALK/TROT DIVISION: Open to riders over 18 years of age. Simple course of 6–8 poles. The flat class will be walk/trot equitation.
